# The Truth about Tithing

Pray for God's power to come through in this message as you work toward scriptural truth behind this subject matter.

## INTRODUCTION

Question: How many of you have heard a sermon on tithing?

Within a very short time of you going to the Sunday Building (a.k.a. "church") you are hit up for a tithe & offerings.

IF pastors and church leadership cannot justify tithing then they would be out of a job.

Scriptures are given to you such as Mal. 3:6-12. "Will a man rob God?" Obvious smart answer is "No (of course you'd be stupid to rob God)" and the consequent solution you are told is to tithe to the building and the pastor which you are also told is the modern day "store house".

"Give unto God", "For the extension of the Kingdom", etc... but is this a correct practice, is it scriptural?

As in ALL issues, this is a non-issue if you are led by the Holy Spirit. But people seem to somewhat nutty when money is involved ... Anyway.

God never changes, TRUE. However the way that we relate to Him certainly has. E.g. because of Jesus we now have direct access to the Father and we no longer need a man to get to God. That was a large part of the curse of the law that was taken care of in Christ Jesus when He fulfilled the law and died upon the cross for our sins.

Our study: With the issue of Godly giving, HOW do we relate to giving under the new covenant?

# **OVERVIEW**

**GOAL:** For the follower of Christ to know how he/she is to relate to the issue of giving and dealing with the resources God has put in their care.

**PURPOSE:** To scripturally clarify the issue of tithing as it relates to the New Covenant.

**OUTCOMES:** For the active listener to understand the foundation of the principle of tithing; the basis of the modern day practice and its implications to the true church; restoration for those in leaders in bondage to this system; a Godly system of giving.

# Part 1 (try to finish in one session)

Joy? How when on Sunday you hear "... God loves a cheerful giver." But it is drudgery and guilt and spiritual blackmail that is put on you in order to extort resources from you. In the process you are told to put a smile on your face and take it. © Again, look at the *context* of the scripture:

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2Co 9:6 But<sup>1161</sup> this<sup>5124</sup> I say, He which soweth<sup>4687</sup> sparingly<sup>5340</sup> shall reap<sup>2325</sup> also<sup>2532</sup> sparingly;<sup>5340</sup> and<sup>2532</sup> he which soweth<sup>4687</sup> bountifully<sup>1909, 2129</sup> shall reap<sup>2325</sup> also<sup>2532</sup> bountifully.<sup>1909, 2129</sup>
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2Co 9:7 Every man<sup>1538</sup> according as<sup>2531</sup> he purposeth<sup>4255</sup> in his heart,<sup>2588</sup> so let him give; not<sup>3361</sup> grudgingly,<sup>1537, 3077</sup> or<sup>2228</sup> of<sup>1537</sup> necessity:<sup>318</sup> for<sup>1063</sup> God<sup>2316</sup> loveth<sup>25</sup> a cheerful<sup>2431</sup> giver.<sup>1395</sup>

There is no joy in the system that the man made churches impose on you because that system is not of God but is rather a system of men designed to support and finance the personal agenda of the leadership; all the while rejecting truth and using Jesus as a means to their own personal ends.

We need to go through this thoroughly because you won't hear this ever in a church but only outside. Incidentally, in the last church age Jesus for the most part outside the overt structure/organization as well (Rev 3:20)

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# First mention is with Abram (later Abraham)

- Gen 14:14 And when Abram<sup>87</sup> heard<sup>8085</sup> that<sup>3588</sup> his brother<sup>251</sup> was taken captive,<sup>7617</sup> he armed<sup>7324</sup> (<sup>853)</sup> his trained<sup>2593</sup> *servants*, born<sup>3211</sup> in his own house,<sup>1004</sup> three<sup>7969</sup> hundred<sup>3967</sup> and eighteen,<sup>8083,6240</sup> and pursued<sup>7291</sup> *them* unto<sup>5704</sup> Dan.<sup>1835</sup>

- 1. Jesus would later be called the High Priest in the order of Melchizedek. (Heb 5:10; Heb 6:20)
  - Heb 5:8 Though<sup>2539</sup> he were<sup>5607</sup> a Son,<sup>5207</sup> yet learned<sup>3129</sup> he obedience<sup>5218</sup> by<sup>575</sup> the things which<sup>3739</sup> he suffered;<sup>3958</sup>
  - Heb 5:9 And<sup>2532</sup> being made perfect,<sup>5048</sup> he became<sup>1096</sup> the author<sup>159</sup> of eternal<sup>166</sup> salvation<sup>4991</sup> unto all<sup>3956</sup> them that obey<sup>5219</sup> him;<sup>846</sup>
  - **Heb 5:10** Called<sup>4316</sup> of<sup>5259</sup> God<sup>2316</sup> a high priest<sup>749</sup> after<sup>2596</sup> the<sup>3588</sup> order<sup>5010</sup> of Melchizedek.<sup>3198</sup>

# Let's get something straight, God owns everything:

**Psa 24:1** A Psalm<sup>4210</sup> of David.<sup>1732</sup> The earth<sup>776</sup> *is* the LORD's,<sup>3068</sup> and the fullness<sup>4393</sup> thereof; the world,<sup>8398</sup> and they that dwell<sup>3427</sup> therein.

HE owns it all, nothing is left over; His world, His bat, His ball. It all belongs to Him; we are simply stewards of it. Carnegie, Rockefeller, Ford, S.W.R.D. Bandaranayke, ... who took any of it with them? NOW, do you think you will?

You own nothing in this world and you take nothing with you. Remember that! Let's continue ...

# The practice of tithing to man has its basis in the rejection of God.

The authorization of the Old Testament system of tithing that emerged was based on 3 <u>REJECTIONS</u> of God's plan by the then people of God. God's original plan for them:

- 1. Of him speaking directly to them. They wanted Moses to do it and tell them what He said (Exo 20:18-19)
- 2. This was followed subsequently by multiple rejections of Moses' instructions (e.g. Exo 24:3) resulting in the emergence of the tribe of Levi for the Old Testament priesthood.
- 3. Of God's Lordship/Kingship over them and wanting a man instead so they could be like everyone else.

# 1 & 2. Just after the giving of the 10 commandments:

Exo 20:18 And all<sup>3605</sup> the people<sup>5971</sup> saw<sup>7200</sup> (853) the thunderings,<sup>6963</sup> and the lightnings,<sup>3940</sup> and the noise<sup>6963</sup> of the trumpet,<sup>7782</sup> and the mountain<sup>2022</sup> smoking:<sup>6226</sup> and when the people<sup>5971</sup> saw<sup>7200</sup> *it*, they removed,<sup>5128</sup> and stood<sup>5975</sup> afar off.<sup>4480, 7350</sup> Exo 20:19 And they said<sup>559</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> Moses,<sup>4872</sup> Speak<sup>1696</sup> thou<sup>859</sup> with<sup>5973</sup> us, and we will hear:<sup>8085</sup> but let not<sup>408</sup> God<sup>430</sup> speak<sup>1696</sup> with<sup>5973</sup> us, lest<sup>6435</sup> we die.<sup>4191</sup>

What would follow later when Moses was off talking to God on behalf of the people was a great falling away with the golden calf:

- Exo 32:19 And it came to pass, $^{1961}$  as soon as $^{834}$  he came nigh $^{7126}$  unto $^{413}$  the camp, $^{4264}$  that he saw $^{7200}$  ( $^{853}$ ) the calf, $^{5695}$  and the dancing: $^{4246}$  and Moses' $^{4872}$  anger $^{639}$  waxed hot, $^{2734}$  and he cast $^{7993}$  ( $^{853}$ ) the tables $^{3871}$  out of his hands, $^{4480}$ , $^{3027}$  and broke $^{7665}$  them beneath $^{8478}$  the mount. $^{2022}$
- Exo 32:20 And he took<sup>3947</sup> (853) the calf<sup>5695</sup> which<sup>834</sup> they had made,<sup>6213</sup> and burnt<sup>8313</sup> *it* in the fire,<sup>784</sup> and ground<sup>2912</sup> *it* to<sup>5704</sup> powder,<sup>834, 1854</sup> and strewed<sup>2219</sup> *it* upon<sup>5921, 6440</sup> the water,<sup>4325</sup> and made (853) the children<sup>1121</sup> of Israel<sup>3478</sup> drink<sup>8248</sup> *of it*.
- Exo 32:21 And Moses<sup>4872</sup> said<sup>559</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> Aaron,<sup>175</sup> What<sup>4100</sup> did<sup>6213</sup> this<sup>2088</sup> people<sup>5971</sup> unto thee, that<sup>3588</sup> thou hast brought<sup>935</sup> so great<sup>1419</sup> a sin<sup>2401</sup> upon<sup>5921</sup> them?
- Exo 32:22 And Aaron<sup>175</sup> said,<sup>559</sup> Let not<sup>408</sup> the anger<sup>639</sup> of my lord<sup>113</sup> wax hot:<sup>2734</sup> thou<sup>859</sup> knowest<sup>3045</sup> (<sup>853</sup>) the people,<sup>5971</sup> that<sup>3588</sup> they<sup>1931</sup> are set on mischief,<sup>7451</sup>
- Exo 32:23 For they said<sup>559</sup> unto me, Make<sup>6213</sup> us gods,<sup>430</sup> which<sup>834</sup> shall go<sup>1980</sup> before<sup>6440</sup> us: for<sup>3588</sup> *as for* this<sup>2088</sup> Moses,<sup>4872</sup> the man<sup>376</sup> that<sup>834</sup> brought us up<sup>5927</sup> out of the land<sup>4480,776</sup> of Egypt,<sup>4714</sup> we know<sup>3045</sup> not<sup>3808</sup> what<sup>4100</sup> is become<sup>1961</sup> of him.
- Exo 32:24 And I said<sup>559</sup> unto them, Whosoever<sup>4310</sup> hath any gold,<sup>2091</sup> let them break *it* off.<sup>6561</sup> So they gave<sup>5414</sup> *it* me: then I cast<sup>7993</sup> it into the fire,<sup>784</sup> and there came out<sup>3318</sup> this<sup>2088</sup> calf.<sup>5695</sup>
- Exo 32:25 And when Moses<sup>4872</sup> saw<sup>7200</sup> that<sup>3588</sup> (853) the people<sup>5971</sup> were naked;<sup>6544</sup> (for<sup>3588</sup> Aaron<sup>175</sup> had made them naked<sup>6544</sup> unto *their* shame<sup>8103</sup> among their enemies:)<sup>6965</sup>
- Exo 32:26 Then Moses<sup>4872</sup> stood<sup>5975</sup> in the gate<sup>8179</sup> of the camp,<sup>4264</sup> and said,<sup>559</sup> Who<sup>4310</sup> *is* on the LORD's<sup>3068</sup> side? *let him come* unto<sup>413</sup> me. And all<sup>3605</sup> the sons<sup>1121</sup> of Levi<sup>3878</sup> gathered themselves together<sup>622</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> him.

- Exo 32:27 And he said<sup>559</sup> unto them, Thus<sup>3541</sup> saith<sup>559</sup> the LORD<sup>3068</sup> God<sup>430</sup> of Israel,<sup>3478</sup> Put<sup>7760</sup> every man<sup>376</sup> his sword<sup>2719</sup> by<sup>5921</sup> his side,<sup>3409</sup> and go in<sup>5674</sup> and out<sup>7725</sup> from gate<sup>4480, 8179</sup> to gate<sup>8179</sup> throughout the camp,<sup>4264</sup> and slay<sup>2026</sup> every man<sup>376</sup> (853) his brother,<sup>251</sup> and every man<sup>376</sup> (853) his companion,<sup>7453</sup> and every man<sup>376</sup> (853) his neighbor.<sup>7138</sup>
- Exo 32:28 And the children<sup>1121</sup> of Levi<sup>3878</sup> did<sup>6213</sup> according to the word<sup>1697</sup> of Moses:<sup>4872</sup> and there fell<sup>5307</sup> of<sup>4480</sup> the people<sup>5971</sup> that<sup>1931</sup> day<sup>3117</sup> about three<sup>7969</sup> thousand<sup>505</sup> men.<sup>376</sup>
- Exo 32:29 For Moses<sup>4872</sup> had said,<sup>559</sup> Consecrate<sup>4390, 3027</sup> yourselves today<sup>3117</sup> to the LORD,<sup>3068</sup> even<sup>3588</sup> every man<sup>376</sup> upon his son,<sup>1121</sup> and upon his brother;<sup>251</sup> that he may bestow<sup>5414</sup> upon<sup>5921</sup> you a blessing<sup>1293</sup> this day.<sup>3117</sup>

This is the beginning of the priesthood of the Levi Priesthood. The Old Testament priesthood is instructed directly to extract tithes of the people.

Heb 7:5 And<sup>2532</sup> verily<sup>3303</sup> they<sup>3588</sup> that are of<sup>1537</sup> the<sup>3588</sup> sons<sup>5207</sup> of Levi,<sup>3017</sup> who receive<sup>2983</sup> the<sup>3588</sup> office of the priesthood,<sup>2405</sup> have<sup>2192</sup> a commandment<sup>1785</sup> to take tithes<sup>586</sup> of the<sup>3588</sup> people<sup>2992</sup> according<sup>2596</sup> to the<sup>3588</sup> law,<sup>3551</sup> that is,<sup>5123</sup> of their<sup>848</sup> brethren,<sup>80</sup> though<sup>2539</sup> they come<sup>1831</sup> out of<sup>1537</sup> the<sup>3588</sup> loins<sup>3751</sup> of Abraham;<sup>11</sup>

# 3. The other was in regards to the request for a King:

- **1Sa** 8:5 And said<sup>559</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> him, Behold,<sup>2009</sup> thou<sup>859</sup> art old,<sup>2204</sup> and thy sons<sup>1121</sup> walk<sup>1980</sup> not<sup>3808</sup> in thy ways:<sup>1870</sup> now<sup>6258</sup> make<sup>7760</sup> us a king<sup>4428</sup> to judge<sup>8199</sup> us like all<sup>3605</sup> the nations.<sup>1471</sup>
- **1Sa 8:6** But the thing<sup>1697</sup> displeased<sup>3415, 5869</sup> Samuel,<sup>8050</sup> when<sup>834</sup> they said,<sup>559</sup> Give<sup>5414</sup> us a king<sup>4428</sup> to judge<sup>8199</sup> us. And Samuel<sup>8050</sup> prayed<sup>6419</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> the LORD.<sup>3068</sup>
- 1Sa 8:7 And the LORD<sup>3068</sup> said<sup>559</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> Samuel,<sup>8050</sup> Hearken<sup>8085</sup> unto the voice<sup>6963</sup> of the people<sup>5971</sup> in all<sup>3605</sup> that<sup>834</sup> they say<sup>559</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> thee: for<sup>3588</sup> they have not<sup>3808</sup> rejected<sup>3988</sup> thee, but<sup>3588</sup> they have rejected<sup>3988</sup> me, that I should not reign<sup>4480,4427</sup> over<sup>5921</sup> them.
- 1Sa 8:8 According to all<sup>3605</sup> the works<sup>4639</sup> which<sup>834</sup> they have done<sup>6213</sup> since the day<sup>4480, 3117</sup> that I brought them up<sup>5927, (853)</sup> out of Egypt<sup>4480, 4714</sup> even unto<sup>5704</sup> this<sup>2088</sup> day,<sup>3117</sup> wherewith they have forsaken<sup>5800</sup> me, and served<sup>5647</sup> other<sup>312</sup> gods,<sup>430</sup> so<sup>3651</sup> do<sup>6213</sup> they<sup>1992</sup> also<sup>1571</sup> unto thee.
- 1Sa 8:9 Now<sup>6258</sup> therefore hearken<sup>8085</sup> unto their voice:<sup>6963</sup> howbeit<sup>389</sup> yet<sup>3588</sup> protest solemnly<sup>5749,5749</sup> unto them, and show<sup>5046</sup> them the manner<sup>4941</sup> of the king<sup>4428</sup> that<sup>834</sup> shall reign<sup>4427</sup> over<sup>5921</sup> them.
- **1Sa** 8:10 And Samuel<sup>8050</sup> told<sup>559</sup> all<sup>3605</sup> the words<sup>1697</sup> of the LORD<sup>3068</sup> unto<sup>413</sup> the people<sup>5971</sup> that asked<sup>7592</sup> of<sup>4480, 854</sup> him a king.<sup>4428</sup>
- 1Sa 8:11 And he said,<sup>559</sup> This<sup>2088</sup> will be<sup>1961</sup> the manner<sup>4941</sup> of the king<sup>4428</sup> that<sup>834</sup> shall reign<sup>4427</sup> over<sup>5921</sup> you: He will take<sup>3947</sup> (<sup>853)</sup> your sons,<sup>1121</sup> and appoint<sup>7760</sup> *them* for himself, for his chariots,<sup>4818</sup> and *to be* his horsemen;<sup>6571</sup> and *some* shall run<sup>7323</sup> before<sup>6440</sup> his chariots.<sup>4818</sup>
- 1Sa 8:12 And he will appoint<sup>7760</sup> him captains<sup>8269</sup> over thousands,<sup>505</sup> and captains<sup>8269</sup> over fifties;<sup>2572</sup> and *will set them* to ear<sup>2790</sup> his ground,<sup>2758</sup> and to reap<sup>7114</sup> his harvest,<sup>7105</sup> and to make<sup>6213</sup> his instruments<sup>3627</sup> of war,<sup>4421</sup> and instruments<sup>3627</sup> of his chariots.<sup>7393</sup>

- 1Sa 8:13 And he will take<sup>3947</sup> your daughters<sup>1323</sup> *to be* confectionaries,<sup>7548</sup> and *to be* cooks,<sup>2879</sup> and *to be* bakers.<sup>644</sup>
- 1Sa 8:14 And he will take<sup>3947</sup> your fields,<sup>7704</sup> and your vineyards,<sup>3754</sup> and your oliveyards,<sup>2132</sup> even the best<sup>2896</sup> of them, and give<sup>5414</sup> them to his servants.<sup>5650</sup>
- 1Sa 8:15 And he will take the tenth 6237 of your seed, 2233 and of your vineyards, 3754 and give 5414 to his officers, 5631 and to his servants. 5650
- 1Sa 8:16 And he will take<sup>3947</sup> your menservants,<sup>5650</sup> and your maidservants,<sup>8198</sup> and your goodliest<sup>2896</sup> young men,<sup>970</sup> and your asses,<sup>2543</sup> and put<sup>6213</sup> *them* to his work.<sup>4399</sup>
- 1Sa 8:17 He will take the tenth 6237 of your sheep: 6629 and ye859 shall be1961 his servants. 5650
- 1Sa 8:18 And ye shall cry out<sup>2199</sup> in that<sup>1931</sup> day<sup>3117</sup> because<sup>4480, 6440</sup> of your king<sup>4428</sup> which<sup>834</sup> ye shall have chosen<sup>977</sup> you; and the LORD<sup>3068</sup> will not<sup>3808</sup> hear<sup>6030</sup> you in that<sup>1931</sup> day,<sup>3117</sup>

In the rejection of God's direct communication with them and His direct reign over them as a people, the tithe being something that was to be set aside unto God (Lev. 27:30-32) was utilized primarily as a resource to sustain a faulted OLD covenant (Heb 8:7-8)

Deu 14:22 Thou shalt truly tithe  $^{6237, \, 6237 \, (853)}$  all  $^{3605}$  the increase  $^{8393}$  of thy seed,  $^{2233}$  that the field  $^{7704}$  bringeth forth  $^{3318}$  year  $^{8141}$  by year.  $^{8141}$

- In remembering the Levite without inheritance many others where to partake as well that were struggling. It did NOT get stuck with them.

## **Even the Levites tithed under the Old Covenant:**

(Num 18:26) Thus speak  $^{1696}$  unto  $^{413}$  the Levites,  $^{3881}$  and say  $^{559}$  unto  $^{413}$  them, When  $^{3588}$  ye take  $^{3947}$  of  $^{4480,\,854}$  the children  $^{1121}$  of Israel  $^{3478}$  ( $^{853}$ ) the tithes  $^{4643}$  which  $^{834}$  I have given  $^{5414}$  you from  $^{4480,\,854}$  them for your inheritance,  $^{5159}$  then ye shall offer up  $^{7311}$  a heave offering  $^{8641}$  of  $^{4480}$  it for the LORD,  $^{3068}$  even a tenth  $^{4643}$  part of  $^{4480}$  the tithe.  $^{4643}$

Function under the Old Covenant as a means of support for the Leviticus priesthood and the OLD TESTAMENT tabernacle worship so that they could in turn facilitate the OLD covenant and as an assigned priesthood. It also supported the king that they people requested to lord over them. The OT priesthood and the tabernacle were shadows of things to come (Heb. 8:1-5; 1 Pet 2:5,9).

#### NOW BRING ALL THIS into the context of Malachi 3:

- A rebuke for not supporting the system God had allowed for based on their choice and rejection of His original plan for them.
- There is no money in heaven.
- The blessing that he would pour even then could not be contained (and my bank account can handle as many zeros as I would put in there).

- This scripture is Old Covenant requiring a parallel bridge into the New Covenant in order for it to be sustained as a practice.

Jesus when walking the earth operating under the Old Covenant in the process of fulfilling the law affirms the practices before the cross but shows how the priorities EVEN THEN were out of place:

(Mat 23:23) Woe $^{3759}$  unto you, $^{5213}$  scribes $^{1122}$  and $^{2532}$  Pharisees, $^{5330}$  hypocrites! $^{5273}$  for $^{1063}$  ye pay tithe $^{586}$  of mint $^{2238}$  and $^{2532}$  anise $^{432}$  and $^{2532}$  cummin, $^{2951}$  and $^{2532}$  have omitted $^{863}$  the $^{3588}$  weightier $^{926}$  matters of the $^{3588}$  law, $^{3551}$  judgment, $^{2920, (2532)}$  mercy, $^{1656}$  and $^{2532}$  faith: $^{4102}$  these $^{5023}$  ought $^{1163}$  ye to have done, $^{4160}$  and not $^{3361}$  to leave $^{863}$  the other $^{2548}$  undone. $^{863}$

A LOT of things were finished when Jesus said "It is finished" before he died on the cross (Joh. 19:30). The righteous requirement of the law was fulfilled and the veil of separation was rent in two in the temple and we were granted access to God through the blood of Jesus Christ. In the Spirit it is a new paradigm with Jesus.

By in large for the first 300 years of the early church they had NO church buildings. The church was who they were, not where they went. They fellowshipped where they had the opportunity to, and this was many times in homes. When persecution came they went not to buildings to find the church but to their homes.

It was not until Constantine in 313 AD adopted Christianity as the official religions of Rome, fusing the new state religion with pagan idolatry to make it acceptable that shortly afterwards you have the emergence of the whole church building craze.

This DISPITE both the Old and New Testament stating that:

In pushing buildings there are also assure the running costs. All the more a reason why it is necessary to convince laypeople to approve the modern day practice of a paid salaried

priesthood and the practice of extracting tithes from the people. The building push for mega churches is primarily fueled by the egos of men who do not know God or fail to understand the new covenant. They want to be a success in the eyes of the world and refuse to end their lives in the same manner as Jesus.

Because the modern day practice is even a violation of the OLD covenant practice (Deut 14:29) you'll often see a "benevolence offering" once a month an attempted blanket cover to show that they indeed do take care of overt areas spoken of in scripture. But in reality these are only the left over scraps.

DO THEY BELIEVE IN WHAT THEY ARE DOING IS SCRIPTURAL? No, it is a matter of what is expedient for their personal agendas.

For the sake of argument; IF there was a legitimate case under the new covenant for a select liturgical group that would extract tithes from the people based on Ephesians 4:

IF there was a select superstar group legitimized to extract tithes from the people based on the Ephesians 4 list and leadership in fact believed it, THEN those in charge of the collection would also insure a 5 way split of resources among those offices, with the office of the Pastor taking a maximum receipt of 20% from what came in for his/her ministry. Does this happen? No. Furthermore, Pastors have the LEAST grounds scripturally for asserting a claim to tithes from the people, even if legitimacy for their right to extract them was accepted. The scriptural role and authority of other "offices" of leadership are highlighted far more throughout the New Testament in the proper functioning and correct administration the true church<sup>1</sup>: Apostles (78 times), Prophets (159 times), Teachers (15 times), and Evangelists (3 times). Pastors are only mentioned ONCE in the entire New Testament (Ephesians 4:11).

What you see today is an unscriptural practice. Under the New Covenant, no man is authorized to extract a tithe from anyone else. The resources of the believer belong to the God the Father to do with and direct as He would in the life of each and every believer at an individual level. It is part of each individual believer's dynamic and personal

relationship with the Holy Spirit where He leads and guides them, impressing upon them the specific needs in the Body of Christ.

When a minister *extracts tithes* from anyone it is both unscriptural and dangerous. Though we do not know Judas' full story we do know that he had a problem with money. We also know that at one point Satan himself entered into him in the betrayal of Jesus. Beware of those who get trained by Satan as one of his ministers due to their rejection of absolute and scriptural truth; Jesus is the way, the truth and the life (John 14:6).

## IN CLOSING

## 1. WHAT IS O.K. For Ministers of the Gospel to do?

• They are entitled to support. YES they are. To allow for people to bless their work and ministry as the Holy Spirit would lead them. But nothing is under compulsion or of obligation.

**Luk 10:7** And<sup>1161</sup> in<sup>1722</sup> the<sup>3588</sup> same<sup>846</sup> house<sup>3614</sup> remain,<sup>3306</sup> eating<sup>2068</sup> and<sup>2532</sup> drinking<sup>4095</sup> such things as they give:<sup>3588, 3844, 846</sup> for<sup>1063</sup> the<sup>3588</sup> laborer<sup>2040</sup> is<sup>2076</sup> worthy<sup>514</sup> of his<sup>848</sup> hire.<sup>3408</sup> Go<sup>3327</sup> not<sup>3361</sup> from<sup>1537</sup> house<sup>3614</sup> to<sup>1519</sup> house.<sup>3614</sup>

The workman is worth of his wages doesn't have anything to do with salaries or the collection of tithes under the New Covenant in Christ. Under the Old Covenant the Levities were instructed to collect tithes of the people under a system of tabernacle worship that was a shadow of reality (Heb 8).

Under the New Covenant a workman being worthy of his wages simple means that God's truly sent ones will be provided for and God will put a burden on the hearts of His other true people to provide for them and help them. The support that they get they are worthy of receiving.

It is part of the fun and the adventure of walking with God in every area of life, including giving and receiving where freely we have received and freely we give. There is a massive difference between giving God's way when He puts a burden on your heart vs. giving to a satanic structure that dishonors God and the New Covenant in Christ.

The modern day practice of tithing to a building/self-proclaimed spiritual leader who is making merchandise of them cuts people off from even hearing God's voice with regards to giving.

## 2. PRACTICAL PRACTICE FOR EVERYONE:

Pro 3:9 Honor<sup>3513</sup> (853) the LORD<sup>3068</sup> with thy substance,<sup>4480, 1952</sup> and with the firstfruits<sup>4480, 7225</sup> of all<sup>3605</sup> thine increase:<sup>8393</sup>

Pro 3:10 So shall thy barns<sup>618</sup> be filled<sup>4390</sup> with plenty,<sup>7647</sup> and thy presses<sup>3342</sup> shall burst out<sup>6555</sup> with new wine.<sup>8492</sup>

It dishonors God to give to something that furthers a satanic system (E.g. Churches that push for war in Iraq). In those cases it is not God that blesses their resources but rather it is Satan. When you give to something that calls wrong right and darkness light because of the outward appearance you do spiritual damage to yourself. Should God bless what is given if it supports Satan's kingdom ... Yes/No? Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil (1 Jon. 3:8)

Which of these please God the most?

- □ Someone gives Rs. 10,000 to a suit wearing global healing evangelist with a gold pinky ring?
- □ Someone gives Rs. 10,000 to help by a new sound equipment and lighting or contribute to the building fund/church budget?
- □ Someone gives a Rs. 10,000 tithe to a 40 lbs. overweight pastor of a mega church?
- □ Someone gives Rs. 10,000 to a poor family that is in need and is struggling to eat?

## 3. THE CONCLUSIONS I'VE COME TO:

- What I do at this point: I DO set aside a tenth part of my income/increase and ask God directly where he would want it to go. (Examples: Roofs, poor, ministry, misc., all sorts of things and whatever the Spirit would give me peace on).
- There IS DEFINITELY a place for supporting the servants of God, but it is as the Spirit leads and not under compulsion. God knows what they need and if you are listening to Him and obedient he will use you at the right time to help them in the mission that they are sent on by God.
- The new covenant it is not a tenth, but total. We belong entirely unto the Father, we are bought and paid for in full and our lives are not our own. "Freely you

- have received, freely give." (Mat. 10:8). What you do or give is without personal agenda and no personal kingdom building. You are instructed to come out of that as it is the way of the world.
- As far as ministers go, leave those who try to sell the truth to you. Don't expect financial gain out of this (Phi 3:8). Be willing to suffer the loss of all things and be above reproach.
- Work hard and help the weak (Acts 20:33-35). Be deliberately generous (2 Co 9)
- Don't be fooled ever again by those who would make merchandise of you. Their Sunday morning performances are not that good. If you are going to pay for a show, go see one you really want to see ©
