JOHN.6

6:53. Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink the blood, ye have no life in you.

- 6:54. Whoso eatheth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 6:55. For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

- 1:27. So God created man in his own image, in the image of Go created he him; male and female created he them.
- o When God created man in the realm of the Spirit as a Spirit being, Eve (female) was in him.
- o God's commission to "be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth" came to Adam, when Eve already was in him.
- This was on the sixth creative (in Hebrew "Melachah" = creative work period) day.

- 2:1.Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host them.
- 2:2.And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.
- 2:3. And God bless the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

- 2:5. And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the Lord God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, AND THERE WAS NOT A MAN TO TILL THE GROUND.
- 2:6. But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the earth.
- 2:7. And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.
- This is really the Eighth day. So God formed man on the Eighth day and man became a living soul, signifying the New beginning.

EIGHTH – New Beginning

- 17:10. This is my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you. And thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised.
- 17:11. And ye shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you.
- 17:12. And he that is EIGHTH days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which is not of thy seed.
- LEVITICUS.12:3. And in the EIGHTH day the flesh of his foreskin shall circumcised.

EIGHTH – New beginning

- OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST ROSE FROM THE ON THE EIGHTH DAY
- Matthew.28:1. In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day (Eight Day) of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.
- Luke. 24:1. Now upon the first day (Eight Day) of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain others with them.

1 CORINTHIANS.15

- 15:45. And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.
- 15:46. Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.
- 15:47. The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven.
- 15:48. As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly.
- 15:49. And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

- 2:20. And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found and help meet for him.
- 2:21.And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof.
- 2:22.AND THE RIB, WHICH THE LORD GOD HAD TAKEN FROM MAN, MADE HE A WOMAN, AND BROUGHT HE UNTO MAN.

JOHN.19

19.34. But one of the soldiers with a spear PIERCED HIS SIDE, and forth with came there out BLOOD AND WATER.

MATTHEW.26

26:28. For this is my blood of the NEW TESTAMENT, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
